Dr. Christina Franke has been a member of the Board of Management of Bosch Rexroth AG since April 2025 with responsibility for manufacturing, quality management and the mobile components business.

After studying mechanical engineering and manufacturing technology at the University of Saarland and spending a year abroad in Sweden, she worked as a research associate at the Chair of Manufacturing Technology starting in 1999. In December 2003, Dr. Franke completed her dissertation on „Process Chain Planning in the Digital Factory“ at the University of Saarland.

In June 2004, she began her professional career in the Bosch Group as a trainee in the then Diesel Systems division, followed by leadership roles in manufacturing and quality management. From 2011 to 2015, she contributed to the establishment of manufacturing at the Powertrain plant in Wuxi, China. This was followed by a position as an advisor to the Bosch management. In 2017, she took over the management of technical project purchasing for Commercial and Offroad Vehicles in Powertrain Solutions within the central purchasing department of the Bosch Group. From mid-2019, she was responsible for engineering in the central research and advanced development department, where she led innovation efforts in the areas of Industry 4.0 and electromobility. Since 2022, she has been active as the head of development in the Business Unit Assembly Technology at Bosch Rexroth in Stuttgart.

Most recently, Dr. Christina Franke served as head of the Business Unit Linear Motion Technology at Bosch Rexroth in Schweinfurt since 2024.
